Nursery: Blossom Class have settled really well into Nursery. They have enjoyed looking at the 'Colour Monster' and making their own monsters with paper, sticks, paper and glue!!!

Reception: Apple Class have settled brilliantly into their new learning environment. They are gradually getting used to our routines and the structure of a long day in school!!

Year 1: Willow Class have settled well in to the new routine. We have been revisiting learning our numbers to 10 making sure we write our digits the correct way round. In English, we have been writing our own sentences

using capital letters, finger spaces and full stops. Willow class looked at where school is and in science learning about our body. The class are enjoying and doing a great job on their weekly Rainbow Challenges.

Year 2: Ash Class have settled into Year 2 so well!
