## Identifying and Supporting Young Carers at Upton Westlea

At Upton Westlea we are aware that some of our pupils are young carers. A young carer is someone under 18 who is caring unpaid for a family member or friend who is ill, frail, disabled or has mental health or addiction problems. They often take on practical and/or emotional caring responsibilities that would normally be expected of an adult. Research suggests there are at least 800,000 young carers in the UK but many do not realise they are a young carer.

We know that young carers may need a little extra support to enjoy and do well at school. At Upton Westlea we are committed to ensuring that all pupils who are young carers are identified, and supported effectively.

Crossroads Together is the commissioned Young Carers service for Cheshire West and Chester. Their Young Carers in Schools Project Worker, Katie Deyes, will be delivering an assembly to raise awareness of young carers in school and the issues they may face. She will be coming back to run a drop in for any students who feel they might be a young carer.
