

Encourage interactions with outdoors and give children freedom to touch, smell and hear the natural world, how we care for the natural world.

Plant beans (Jack and the Beanstalk, Jaspar's Beanstalk), minibeasts, tadpoles, caterpillars and bug hotel. Recognising some environments are different to the one in which they live.

## Literacy

Ongoing Little Wandle Phonics and Reading Blend sounds into words, so that they can read short words made up of known letter- sound correspondences • Read some letter groups that each represent one sound and say sounds for them • Read and write simple phrases and sentences made up of words with known letter-sound correspondences and, where necessary, a few exception words. • Read a few common exception words matched to the school's phonic programme.

Return and build on their previous learning, refining ideas and developing their ability to represent them. Create collaboratively, sharing ideas, resources and skills (transient art, bug hotel). Develop storylines in their pretend play. Ongoing use of artistic effects to express ideas and feelings. Art work linked to Growing and Changes

### Communication and Language

- Express ideas and feeling about their experiences using full sentences, including use of past, present and future tenses, and making use of conjunctions with modelling and support from adults.
- Make comments about what they have heard and ask questions to clarify their understanding.

# PSHE

Work cooperatively and make relationships with others. Express feelings. 'No Outsiders' book -The Family Book Be confident to try new activities and show independence, resilience and perseverance in the face of challenge. Set and work to simple goals, being able to wait for what they want.
