Geography

In Geography, they will be learning about the key aspects of a tropical climate and the layers of the Rainforest. They will learn about the animals and plants living in the Rainforest. They will also learn about the effects that humans are having on the trees and forests through deforestation.

Computing

In computing, we will be looking at photo editing.

Science

In Science, our focus will be on living things and their habitats. We will be grouping living things in a variety of ways using classification keys and recognising that environments can change, posing potential dangers to living things.

Maths

Throughout Summer One, we will continue our learning of money and begin our new topic of mass, volume and length.

English

In English, our focus will be on non-fiction writing. Using two fantastic books (Rainforests in 30 Seconds and Where the Forest Meets the Sea) as the foundations for our learning, our aim is to write a non-chronological report to be used as a zoo information display. We will develop varied and rich vocabulary throughout.

In music, we will be looking at the pentatonic scale - a five-note musical scale, which takes its name from the Latin 'penta' meaning five, and 'tonus', which means sound or tone.

We will also be looking at one of the first ever motion pictures of a horse running.
